### INFORMATION REGARDING ALL GARBAGE COLLECTIONS

*Please do not block the roadway when placing garbage, recycling or bulk items at curbside.*

<b>GARBAGE COLLECTION</b>	The <b>2005 Garbage, Recycling and Bulk pick up schedule</b> was mailed out in our Fall/Winter Newsletter. The schedule is also available on our web page <a href="http://www.andoverwp-nj.com">www.andoverwp-nj.com</a> or by calling 973-383-4280, ext. 224, and requesting one be mailed to you.
<b>CO-MINGLED RECYCLING</b>	Use a <u>permanent type container</u> for pickup. Do not place your recycling in plastic bags. Plastic bags are not acceptable; therefore, your recycling will not be picked up. <b>Recycling is mandated by the State of New Jersey. Fines can be imposed if you do not comply.</b>
<b>BULK ITEMS</b>	Bulk items are to be placed curbside during <u>bulk cleanup week only</u> . Residents leaving bulk items curbside at any other time may be subject to fines.
<b>LEAVES</b>	Leaves will be picked up during the month of November only. All leaves <i>must</i> be put in large paper (recyclable) leaf bags. Plastic bags are not acceptable.
<b>BRUSH PICK UP</b>	Brush pick up will be <b>October 1, 2005 through April 15, 2006</b> , weather permitting. The cut end of the brush must be facing the roadway and be neatly piled, not crossed. The maximum diameter of limbs is <b>3 inches</b> . For safety reasons, thorn bushes and briar bushes <b>will not</b> be picked up. <b>Please note:</b> brush pick up is for our <i>residents' convenience</i> when clearing away overgrown trees and bushes, or when storm damage occurs. We do not have the man power or large machinery to pick up huge amounts of brush. Any <b>commercially cut</b> trees or bushes causing an abundance of brush can not be picked up by our D.P.W. crew. The SCMGA Recycling Center located on Rte. 94 in Lafayette is available to all residents. Their phone number is 973-579-6998.
<b>WASTE OIL DROP OFF</b> <i>Motor Oil Only</i>	Drop off is the <b>last Friday</b> of each month, between the hours of 8:00 - 10:00 A.M. at the Municipal Garage (upper parking lot), 134 Newton-Sparta Road. <b>Please do not drop off the motor oil at any other time.</b> Due to a Friday <b>Holiday</b> in November, drop off will be November 18, 2005.

Freon Removal from Refrigerators, Freezers & Air Conditioners = \$10.00 per unit  
Fee for 6 tires or less = \$2.50 per car tire  
Truck Tires (Not To Exceed 11.20) = w/o rims \$7.50 per truck tire  
w/ rims \$15.00 per truck tire  
Tractor /Oversized Tires (over 11.20) = Weight Rate + \$100 per tire
