## INFORMATION REGARDING ALL GARBAGE COLLECTIONS

Please do not block the roadway when placing garbage, recycling or bulk items

GARBAGE COLLECTION	The 2005 Garbage, Recycling and Bulk pick up schedule was mailed out in our Fall/Winter Newsletter. The schedule is also available on our web page <a href="www.andovertwp-nj.com">www.andovertwp-nj.com</a> or by eailing 973-383-4280, ext. 224, and requesting one be mailed to you.
CO-MINGLED RECYCLING	Use a <u>permanent type container</u> for pickup. <u>Do not</u> place your recycling in plastic bags. Plastic bags are not acceptable; therefore, your recycling will not be picked up. Recycling is mandated by the State of New Jersey. Fines can be imposed if you do not comply.
BULK ITEMS	Balk items are to be piaced eurbside during <u>bulk cleanup week <i>only</i></u> . Residents leaving bulk items curbside at any other time may be subject to fines.
LEAVES	Leaves will be picked up during the month of November only. All leaves <i>must</i> be put in large paper (recyclable) leaf bags. Plastic bags are not acceptable.
BRUSH PICK EP	Brash pick up will be October 1, 2005 through April 15, 2006, weather permitting. The cut end of the brash must be facing the roadway and be neatly piled, not crossed. The maximum diameter of limbs is 3 inches. For safety reasons, than bashes and briar bushes will not be picked up. Please note: brash pick up is for our revidents' convenience when clearing away overgrown trees and bushes, or when storm damage occurs. We do not have the man power or large machinery to pick up huge amounts of brash. Any commercially cut trees or bushes causing an abundance of brash can not be picked up by our D.P.W. crew. The SCMUA Recycling Center located on Ric. 94 in Lafayene is available to all residents. Their phone number is 973-579-6998.
WASTE OIL DROP OFF Motor Oil Only	Drop off is the last Friday of each month, between the hours of 8:00 - 10:00 A.M. at the Municipal Garage (upper parking lot), 134 Newton-Sparta Road. Please do not drop off the motor oil at any other time. Due to a Friday Holiday in November, drop off will be November 18, 2005.
