If we learn that he is, we would approach Diane Gillespie to see if she would be interested in giving her input since she has expertise in that area. Mike Morel said he would get in touch with Dennis Rupp since they are neighbors. We still have time since the winter weather would not allow us to do much at this time.

1. Discussion with William Clark re membership: Bill called to say he will not be available for this meeting so we will meet with him in April.
2. Finalize Plans for Easter Egg Hunt – April 16th – We will advertise that people should bring their cameras to take a picture with the Easter Bunny. We will add some “special” eggs where they get a golden ticket meaning they get a prize. We will have 3 prize specials in each age group – Toddlers – Kindergarten – 1st & 2nd Grade – 3rd & 4th . We will have goodie bags for each child also. Maechele offered to help either fill the eggs or fill the bags. We can also do some of this work at our next meeting if necessary. We will also get more plastic eggs to replenish our egg supply.
3. Any discussion brought before the committee by members present: We reviewed the activities planned for this year: Easter Egg Hunt on April 16th; Little Miss and Mr. Andover Township and Miss Andover Township on June 5th; Summer Recreation Program –First week is Monday-Thursday, June 27th-June 30th and the second week is Tuesday-Friday, July 5th- July 8th; Summer Sports Camp – July 11th -15th and Tennis Camp – July 18th – July 22nd; End of Summer Labor Day Weekend Family Movie Day – Sept. 3rd with rain date of Sept. 4th ; Sept. 24th – 2nd Annual Charity Softball Tournament; October 16th – Senior Luncheon; October 30th – Children’s Halloween Party; November 18th – Annual Fall Teen Dance; December 3rd – Annual NYC Bus Trip; December 4th – Annual Children’s Holiday Party. We certainly will be busy!
