CROSS TRAINING/20/20/20 – MARCH 18TH - JUNE 12TH: The Spring Session of Cross Training/20-20-20 will begin on Monday, March 18th and continues on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings ending on Thursday, June 12th, with the following exception: no classes on Monday, May 27th and Monday, June 3rd and Thursday, June 6th. CLEANER, GREENER ANDOVER TOWNSHIP NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN UP - APRIL 13TH : The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection funds a Clean Communities Program whereby municipalities are given a sum of money to be used to provide trash bags, gloves and other protective clothing to encourage volunteers to clean up solid waste in their localities. Andover Township participates with this program by funding volunteer groups such as Student Council, Boy and Girl Scout Troops, etc. to periodically clean debris from alongside various township roads. **Pre-registration is mandatory** so we can make a plan to ensure everyone has an appropriate assignment. Come to Hillside Park by 9 AM for a light breakfast and then out to the roads! After you have completed your clean up, you are invited back to the park for a pizza lunch at 12 noon. The groups that participate are given supplies for clean up and also a donation to their organization. We are accepting car and truck tires w/wo rims that must be free of debris. We have also arranged for electronic waste collection – computers, printers, televisions, VCR's, copiers, etc. The E waste container and tire drop off will be located in lower parking lot.
