A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ANDOVER, COUNTY OF SUSSEX AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEMANDING TEN (10) DAYS CREDIT TO BE AWARDED BY SERVICE ELECTRIC CABLE TV AND COMMUNICATIONS TO THE TOWNSHIP OF ANDOVER FOR LOSS OF SERVICE DURING SUPERSTORM SANDY

WHEREAS, Service Electric Cable TV and Communications ("Service Electric") is the franchise cable provider for the Township of Andover ("Township"); and

WHEREAS, during Superstorm Sandy, Township residents were without power, including cable services, for a period of at least ten (10) days; and

WHEREAS, utilities have rightfully agreed to give credit for lost services during Superstorm Sandy; and

WHEREAS, Service Electric has only agreed to give a credit of two (2) days for lost cable services during Superstorm Sandy

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Township Committee of the Township of Andover, County of Sussex and State of New Jersey that the Township is demanding a credit of ten (10) days from Service Electric for lost services during Superstorm Sandy on behalf of its residents based upon the suffering, volunteering and other efforts of Township residents during the storm.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
