Fiber: Bundled together and tied or put in a container. Cardboard; Newspapers; Magazines;

Mail/Paper; Food and tissues boxes.

Commingled: Glass, Plastic, Aluminum, Tin, and wax coated containers.

Appliance and Metal Pick Up: Freon must be removed.

Call to schedule pick-up, Pick up is the last Wednesday of each month.

2025 TRASH AND RECYCING INFORMATION

SERVICES HANDLED BY THE TOWNSHIP DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

BRUSH PICK-UP: ONLY DURING OCTOBER AND APRIL, weather permitting. There is no fee for this service. **You must sign up for collection** to more efficiently schedule pick-ups. Please visit our website, andovertwp.org to view the schedule and download the application, or call **973-383-4280** to have the form emailed. The form is also available at the Municipal Building.

Applications will not be accepted after the cut off dates of March 31st for the April Brush collection and September 30th for the October Brush collection.

Please note the following: Brush, including, but not limited to, all branches, bulky tree limbs and tree trunks, must be deposited in a 4'x4'x6' pile with cut ends facing the road and placed at the curb. If curb does not exist, brush shall be placed near the street but not on the street pavement itself. Brush <u>should not</u> be placed closer than ten (10) feet from any storm drain inlet. The following items <u>will not</u> be collected: leaves, grass clippings, vines, bamboo or tall landscape grasses. **NOTE:** Brush pick up is for our <u>residents'</u> convenience when clearing away overgrown trees and bushes, or when storm damage occurs. Any commercially cut trees or bushes causing an abundance of brush <u>will not</u> be picked up by our DPW crew. The SCMUA Recycling Center located on Rte. 94 in Lafayette is available to all residents. Their phone number is 973-579-6998.

LEAF PICKUP: The entire month of November. Leaves must be in brown paper bags or other biodegradable bags. No sign up required.

<u>CHRISTMAS TREE DROP OFF</u> During the Month of January, trees should be brought to the lower parking lot at Hillside Park, Lake Iliff Road. When weather permits, the trees will be chipped into mulch and will be available to all residents. *Christmas trees will not be picked up curbside.*

WASTE OIL DROP OFF DAYS Last Friday of each month between the hours of 8AM & 10AM at Municipal Garage (upper parking lot). Dates are only changed if holiday falls on the last Friday.

Plastic Bags should <u>not</u> be thrown out in trash or with recyclables. They can be recycled at most grocery and department stores.

Styrofoam: SCMUA has successfully instituted a Styrofoam recycling program. Sussex County residents can bring Styrofoam to SCMUA for recycling. At this time Styrofoam cannot be put with commingled recycling, if you don't want to make the trip to SCMUA, Styrofoam will continue to be put with household trash (even if there is a recycling triangle on it).

<u>Rechargeable Battery Recycling</u>: Rechargeable batteries (Ni-Cd, Ni-MH, Li-ion, Ni-Zn, small sealed lead less than 11 lbs.) can be recycled at the SCMUA.

Non-rechargeable Single Use Batteries: When primary cell/non-rechargeable (AA, AAA, C, D, 6V, 9V, 1.5V) batteries are discharged, it is appropriate to put them in trash or bring to SCMUA for disposal.

**Please note batteries will no longer be accepted at the municipal building.

<u>Paper Shredding</u>: Third Friday of every month at the SCMUA from 9AM to 12PM; \$6 minimum, no limits, cash or checks only.

<u>Mixed Rigid Plastics (MRP)</u>: Storage containers, tubs, shelving, toys (houses, cars, trikes), buckets, crates, laundry baskets, and lawn furniture can be brought to the SCMUA. Material is weighed and SCMUA charges a disposal fee.

<u>Tires and Construction Debris:</u> Must be brought to the SCMUA. It is not in the township contract with the hauler, so it will not be picked up at the curb. However, if you are replacing a broken sink or toilet, that can be put at the curb.

Electronics: Not to be put curbside / Must be properly recycled. The SCMUA and all landfills have been notified by the state that landfill disposal of electronics is prohibited (NJ mandate effective: 1/1/2011) SCMUA periodically offers free e-cycle days. If electronics are brought to the landfill any other time, the weight of the item(s) will determine the cost.
