N.J.S.A. APP. A:9-40.1 AND DIRECTIVE NUMBER 102

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Office of Emergency Management requires each municipality to appoint an "Emergency Management Coordinator" pursuant to N.J.S.A. App. A9-40.1 and Directive Number 102 issued by the State Office of Emergency Management on March 15, 1990; and

**WHEREAS**, the Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, Office of Emergency Management for the Township of Andover shall serve a term of three years; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator is responsible for the planning, activating, coordinating and the conduct of Emergency Management operations with the municipality; and

**WHEREAS,** it is the intention of the Township Committee of the Township of Andover to comply with the requirements set forth under the provisions of J.J.S.A. App. A:9-40.1 of the State Disaster Control Act and Directive Number 102; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Governing Body of the Township of Andover that Eric Danielson is hereby re-appointed as the Municipal Emergency Management Coordinator, and George Laoudis and Richard Bartlett as Deputy Emergency Management Coordinators, all for 3-year terms expiring on December 31, 2026.
