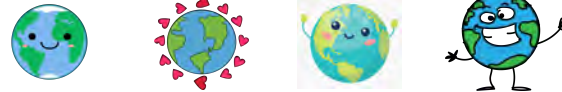

ELECTION INFORMATION

New Jersey's Primary Elections are June 4. New Jersey law also requires that voters be registered to vote in the municipality/district where they currently reside... so if you've moved recently, you'll want to confirm you're registered at your current address.

THE NEXT SCHEDULED ELECTIONS ARE ...
June 4 Primary Elections (Democratic & Republican parties) The Primary elections are statewide for registered voters who affiliate with either the Democratic or Republican party. In addition to Election Day voting, early in-person voting will be available, as will early voting by mail. the deadline to register to vote for this election is May 14th.
November 5 General Election Early in-person voting will be available for this election, as will early voting by mail. The deadline to register to vote for this election is OCTOBER 15th.
